CITY OF OKEECHOBEE, FLORIDA DECEMBER 15, 2020, REGULAR CITY COUNCIL DRAFT MEETING MINUTES

I. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Watford called the regular meeting of the City Council for the City of Okeechobee to order on Tuesday, December 15, 2020, at 6:02 P.M. in the City Council Chambers, located at 55 Southeast 3rd Avenue, Room 200, Okeechobee, Florida. The invocation was offered by Mayor Watford, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Council Member Clark.

II. ATTENDANCE

To establish a quorum, roll was taken by City Clerk Lane Gamiotea. Members present: Mayor Dowling R. Watford, Jr., Council Members Wes Abney, Monica Clark, Bob Jarriel, and Bobby Keefe.

III. AGENDA AND PUBLIC COMMENTS

A. No items were added, deferred, or withdrawn from the agenda.

- **B.** Motion by Council Member Abney, seconded by Council Member Jarriel to approve the agenda as presented. **Motion Carried Unanimously**.
- **C.** There were no comment cards submitted for public participation for issues not on the agenda.

IV. CONSENT AGENDA

Motion by Council Member Clark, seconded by Council Member Keefe to approve consent agenda items **A**, November 17, 2020 and December 1, 2020 Regular Meeting minutes, and **B**, November 2020 Warrant Register. **Motion Carried Unanimously**.

V. MAYOR WATFORD OPENED THE PUBLIC HEARING AT 6:05 P.M.

A. Motion by Council Member Clark, seconded by Council Member Keefe to adopt proposed Resolution No. 2020-19 regarding Non-ad valorem Special Assessments.

Attorney Fumero read proposed Resolution No. 2020-19 by title only as follows: "A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OKEECHOBEE, FLORIDA; ADOPTING METHOD LEVY, THE FOR THE COLLECTION UNIFORM AND ENFORCEMENT OF NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENTS PURSUANT TO SECTION 197.3632, FLORIDA STATUTES FOR DRAINAGE, ROAD IMPROVEMENTS, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO ROADSIDE DITCHES, SWALES, CULVERTS, AND SIDEWALKS, STREET LIGHTING, STREET RESURFACING, CANAL OR DITCH CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE, FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES AND FACILITIES, STORMWATER TREATMENT, MOSQUITO CONTROL, THE ABATEMENT OF NUISANCES AS DESCRIBED IN CHAPTER 30, SECTIONS 30-31 TO 30-46, OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES AND CHAPTER 60 FLORIDA STATUTES. AT CERTAIN PROPERTIES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE COST OF ABATING OF NUISANCES AS PROVIDED IN THE AFOREMENTIONED SECTIONS OF THE CITY CODE AND FLORIDA STATUTES AS AMENDED FROM TIME TO TIME, WITHIN THE INCORPORATED AREA OF THE CITY OF OKEECHOBEE, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE." Motion Carried Unanimously.

B. Motion by Council Member Keefe, seconded by Council Member Clark to read proposed Ordinance No. 1221 by title only updating the Five-Year Capital Improvement Element of the Comprehensive Plan. **Motion Carried Unanimously**.

Attorney Fumero read proposed Ordinance No. 1221 by title only as follows: "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OKEECHOBEE, FLORIDA; UPDATING THE FIVE-YEAR SCHEDULE OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS OF THE CITY'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AS MANDATED BY FLORIDA STATUTES SECTION 163.3177(3)(b); PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

Motion by Council Member Jarriel, seconded by Council Member Clark to approve the first reading and set January 5, 2021 as the Final Public Hearing date for proposed Ordinance No. 1221. **Motion Carried Unanimously**.

- C. Motion by Council Member Jarriel, seconded by Council Member Keefe to award Bid No. PW 01-10-11-20 Southeast 6th Street Paving Improvement Project to Excavation Point, Inc. in the amount of \$38,924.00. Motion Carried Unanimously.
- **D.** Motion by Council Member Keefe, seconded by Council Member Clark approve additional fees in the amount of \$4,458.00 for the implementation of services for the eSCRIBE software. **Motion Carried Unanimously**.
- E. Motion by Council Member Clark, seconded by Council Member Abney to adopt vendor fees for Police Officer special and/or holiday detail effective October 1, 2020. Motion Carried Unanimously.
- F. Motion by Council Member Abney, seconded by Council Member Jarriel to adopt Police Officer rate of pay for special and/or holiday detail effective October 1, 2020. Motion Carried Unanimously.
- **G.** Motion by Council Member Clark, seconded by Council Member Abney to approve the 100 percent option for Fire Department employees for annual and sick leave as presented. **Motion Carried Unanimously**.

ORDINANCE NO. 1221

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OKEECHOBEE, FLORIDA; UPDATING THE FIVE-YEAR SCHEDULE OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS OF THE CITY'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AS MANDATED BY FLORIDA STATUTES SECTION 163.3177(3)(b); PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

- WHEREAS, Florida Statutes Section 163.3177(3)(b) requires local governments to annually update a Five-Year Schedule of Capital Improvements which is consistent with the Plan and may be accomplished by ordinance rather than as an amendment to the Local Comprehensive Plan; and
- WHEREAS, the City's Planning Board, acting as the Local Planning Agency, has reviewed the proposed Five-Year Schedule of Capital Improvements, at a duly advertised meeting held on November 19, 2020 and hereby forwards its recommendation to the City Council; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council has agreed with the recommendations of the Planning Board that the proposed Five-Year Schedule of Capital Improvements complies with the requirements of Florida Statutes Section 163.3177(3)(b), that the proposed improvements are consistent with the Comprehensive Plan; and
- **WHEREAS,** the City Council desires to adopt this Schedule to guide future development of the City and protect the public's health, safety, and welfare.
- **NOW, THEREFORE,** be it ordained before the City Council for the City of Okeechobee, Florida; presented at a duly advertised public meeting; and passed by majority vote of the City Council; and properly executed by the Mayor or designee, as Chief Presiding Officer for the City:

SECTION 1: Revision. The City Council hereby revises the Capital Improvements Element of its Comprehensive Plan by updating the Five-Year Schedule of Capital Improvements (Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan) attached as Exhibit "A":

SECTION 2: **Conflict.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: **Severability.** If any provision or portion of this ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be void, unconstitutional, or unenforceable, then all remaining provisions and portions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

Subject:	Capital Improvement Schedule Update for 2020-2021

Each year, the City is required to update its Five-Year Schedule of Capital Improvements in the Capital Improvements Element (CIE) of the Comprehensive Plan. This schedule typically includes those capital expenditures that are necessary to maintain the adopted level of service standards identified in the Comprehensive Plan. The City has adopted level of service standards for potable water, sanitary sewer, solid waste, transportation, recreation & open space, drainage and public schools. Projects that are typically included on the schedule include public works types of improvements such as street paving, sidewalks, curb & gutter, stormwater/ drainage, and recreation improvements. The City does not directly control public school standards or the related projects to maintain the standards. Nevertheless, the City is required to adopt the level of service standards set by the Okeechobee County School Board and include in its Five-Year Schedule, the Okeechobee County School Capacity Program adopted by the School Board each year as part of its annual Work Plan.

Due to the legislative changes passed in 2011, the annual update to the capital improvement schedule is still required, but the update is no longer considered an amendment to the City's Comprehensive Plan. The LPA (Planning Board) must still hold a public hearing and make a recommendation to the City Council concerning the update's consistency with the Comprehensive Plan. This recommended update specifically implements the requirements of Objective 4 and Policies 4.3 and 4.4 of the Capital Facilities Element.

As you'll see, the previous 2019-20 five year capital improvement schedule is stricken and replaced by the 2020-21 schedule. Similarly, the previous 2018-19 school district tables are stricken and have been replaced by the latest tables from the School District's 2019-20 Work Plan. The School District informed us that the 2020-21 Work Plan is not yet finalized.

EXHIBIT A

City of Okeechobee Comprehensive Plan Capital Improvements Element Amended: October 18, 2011

Capital Improvements Element

Goals, Objectives and Policies

Goal:	The City of Okeechobee shall continue to ensure that public facilities and services are provided, on a fair-share costs basis, in a manner which maximizes the use of existing facilities and promotes orderly growth.
Objective 1:	The City of Okeechobee shall continue to use the Capital Improvements Element to schedule construction and identify funding sources for the City's capital facility needs in order to accommodate existing and future development, and to replace obsolete or worn-out facilities.
Policy 1.1:	Proposed capital improvements projects shall continue to be ranked and evaluated according to appropriate policies adopted in other elements of the Comprehensive Plan. The following criteria will also be considered:
	 (1) whether the proposed project will eliminate a public hazard; (2) whether the proposed project will eliminate capacity deficits; (3) local budget impacts;
	(4) locational needs based on projected growth patterns;(5) accommodation of new development or redevelopment;
	(6) financial feasibility; and(7) plans of state agencies or water management districts that provide facilities in Okeechobee.
Policy 1.2:	The City of Okeechobee shall continue to integrate its planning and budgeting processes such that expenditures which are budgeted for capital improvements recognize policies related to public facilities and services set forth in the Comprehensive Plan.
Policy 1.3:	In accordance with Policy 7.1 of the Sanitary Sewer Element, the City shall complete a stormwater management study to identify drainage deficiencies, and allocate any available funds for that purpose in its Administrative Operating Budget for fiscal year 2013. The 5-Year Schedule of Capital Improvements will be amended as soon as possible to include the study, its projected cost, and the identified revenue source(s).
Policy 1.4:	The City of Okeechobee shall identify its needs for public facility improvements, the revenues required for project funding, and shall itemize the costs for such projects in its 5-Year Schedule of Capital Improvements.
Objective 2:	The City of Okeechobee shall continue to coordinate land use decisions with the schedule of capital improvements in a manner that maintains the adopted level of service standards and meets existing and future needs.

Policy 2.2:	Development orders and permits shall be granted only when required public
	facilities and services are operating at the established levels of service, or
	shall be available concurrent with the impacts of the development. Such
	facilities and services may be provided in phases if development
	correspondingly occurs in phases; however, required service levels must be
	maintained at all times during the development process.

- Policy 2.3: The City of Okeechobee will maintain a water supply facilities work plan that is coordinated with SFWMD's District Water Supply Plan and the Okeechobee Utility Authority (OUA) by updating its own work plan within 18 months of an update to SFWMD's District Water Supply Plan that affects the City.
- Policy 2.4: The City of Okeechobee recognizes that it relies upon the Okeechobee Utility Authority (OUA) facilities for the provision of potable water for its residents, businesses and visitors, and as such the City is part of the greater SFWMD, and that the continued supply of potable water will be dependent upon all local governments striving to maintain demand for potable water at sustainable levels. As such, the City will:
 - (1) Continue to maintain relationships with the SFWMD and the Okeechobee Utility Authority (OUA) to maintain or reduce potable water consumption through education, conservation, and participation in ongoing programs of the region, county and city including coordinating local conservation education efforts with the SFWMD and the Okeechobee Utility Authority (OUA) programs.
 - (2) Require landscaping in all new development or redevelopment on public water systems to use water-efficient landscaping and require functioning rain-sensor devices on all new automatic irrigation systems.
 - (3) The City of Okeechobee shall inform residents and businesses of, and shall encourage their participation in, the Okeechobee Utility Authority (OUA) water conservation programs if they become available.
- Policy 2.5: The City of Okeechobee recognizes that the Okeechobee Utility Authority (OUA) provides potable water to the City, its businesses and residents. Although no capital improvement projects are necessary within the City for which the City of Okeechobee has financial responsibility in connection with supply of potable water to the City, its businesses and residents, the City of Okeechobee will support and coordinate with the Okeechobee Utility Authority (OUA), as necessary, to assist in the implementation of Okeechobee Utility Authority (OUA) Capital Improvements projects for the years 2011-2021.

Objective 3:	In order to maintain adopted level of service standards, future development shall bear a proportionate cost of necessary public facility improvements equivalent to the benefits it receives from the improvements.
Policy 3.1:	The City of Okeechobee shall continue to evaluate potential revenue available for public facility expenditures through alternative sources such as user fees, special benefit units, or special assessments.
Policy 3.2:	The City of Okeechobee shall continue to maintain adopted levels of service by using revenue sources considered under Policy 3.1 to ensure that new development pays a pro rata share of the costs of public facility needs which it generates.
Policy 3.3:	The City of Okeechobee shall continue to continue to apply for and secure grants or private funds when available to finance the provision of capital improvements.
Objective 4:	The City of Okeechobee shall continue to ensure the provision of needed public facilities within the City limits, based on adopted levels of service as set forth in the Comprehensive Plan. Public facilities needs shall be determined on the basis of previously issued development orders as well as the City's budgeting process and its joint activities with Okeechobee County and the Okeechobee County School District for planning, zoning, and concurrency management.
Policy 4.1:	Existing and future public facilities shall operate at the levels of service established in this plan.
Policy 4.2:	Debt service shall not exceed 20% of annually budgeted revenues.
Policy 4.3:	A five-year capital improvements program and annual capital budget shall be adopted as part of the City of Okeechobee's annual budgeting process. This program shall include the annual review, and revision as needed, of the Five- Year Schedule of Capital Improvements.
Policy 4.4:	The financially feasible School District Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (Tentative Facilities Work Program) which achieves and maintains the adopted level of service standards for public schools, as approved by the Okeechobee County School Board shall be included and adopted each year as part of the City of Okeechobee's annual budgeting process.
Objective 5:	The City of Okeechobee shall furnish meaningful opportunities for the School Board to have input and coordination in the City's development review process in order to assist the School Board in their provision of adequate and efficient schools.

Policy 5.1: The City of Okeechobee and the School Board shall coordinate to ensure that schools are adequately and efficiently provided commensurate with growth. Key coordinating mechanisms shall include:

- (a) promotion of joint infrastructure park/school facilities when feasible;
- (b) consideration of the adequacy and availability of educational infrastructure during appropriate review of development order applications;
- (c) ensuring the provision of adequate infrastructure, on and off site, normally associated with new or expanded schools where consistent with state law restrictions on expenditures by the School Board;
- (d) evaluation of the School District's annually updated Capital Improvement Plan to ensure that it is financially feasible and that the adopted level-of-service standard for public schools is achieved and maintained;
- (e) seeking that any new major residential development or redevelopment applicant submit information regarding projected school enrollments from the project; and
- (f) request that the School Board submit site plan information for all timely new schools.

Capital Improvements Implementation

City of Okeechobee Comprehensive Plan

Capital improvement needs identified in the Comprehensive Plan will be met through implementation of a 5-Year Schedule of Capital Improvements. This schedule is adopted by the City Council along with Goals, Objectives and Policies, and must be consistent with the Capital Improvements Element. The purpose of the Schedule is to ensure that the City has adequate revenues to implement the Comprehensive Plan.

The 5-Year Schedule of Capital Improvements focuses on the capital outlay required to meet existing deficiencies and to maintain adopted level of service standards planned for public facilities in the Plan. The City shall advise the OUA on these standards.

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OKEECHOBEE, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE FLAGLER PARK DESIGN REVIEW ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

- WHEREAS, the City of Okeechobee City Council seeks to improve and beautify its parks and Flagler Park in particular; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council may, from time to time, establish a design review board for the purposes and tasks it deems appropriate in accordance with Chapter 70, Code of Ordinances; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council seeks to appoint a group of interested citizens to serve on the Flagler Park Design Review Advisory Committee; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council desires to create a forum for citizens to participate in all aspects of the Flagler Park design and improvements and to solicit citizen input regarding proposed and potential improvements and enhancements to Flagler Park.
- NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved before the City Council for the City of Okeechobee, Florida; presented at a duly advertised public meeting; and passed by majority vote of the City Council; and properly executed by the Mayor or designee, as Chief Presiding Officer for the City:
- SECTION 1: The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated in this Resolution.
- SECTION 2: The City Council hereby creates and establishes the City of Okeechobee FLAGLER PARK DESIGN REVIEW ADVISORY COMMITTEE (FPDRAC) which will act in accordance with, and subject to, the provisions, duties, and limitations of this Resolution.
- SECTION 3: Purpose. The FPDRAC's purpose is to gather analysis and information, and make recommendations to the City Council concerning improvements to Flagler Park. FPDRAC shall advise and recommend to City Council proposed Flagler Park improvements, landscape plans, structures, signs, design guidelines and other relevant considerations based upon their deliberations and public input.
- SECTION 4: The FPDRAC shall be constituted and function as follows:
 - a. FPDRAC shall be comprised of seven (7) members who serve at the pleasure of the City Council in an advisory capacity. Up to Two alternate members may be appointed to FPDRAC. Such alternate shall attend all meetings and fully participate in FPDRAC discussions and deliberations to the point of voting. Should any permanent member be absent, the chairperson shall declare the alternate to be a voting member for the duration of the meeting. Vacancies on the FPDRAC shall be filled by appointment of the City Council for the unexpired term of the member affected. It shall be the duty of the FPDRAC Chairperson to notify the Mayor within ten days after a vacancy shall occur among the members or alternate member.
 - b. The City Council makes the final determination in which persons sit on the FPDRAC. FPDRAC at no time shall have the power to appoint, to fill a vacancy, or replace a member without the written consent of the City Council. The City Council shall have authority to create, direct, or dissolve the FPDRAC.
 - c. Terms. The terms of the FPDRAC shall begin immediately upon appointment of all members, and sunset one year from the date of the first meeting, or as City Council may otherwise determine.
 - d. Compensation. All members of the FPDRAC shall serve without pay.

- e. Attendance. Members shall be automatically removed for lack of attendance. Lack of attendance is defined as failure to attend three consecutive meetings or failure to attend more than one half of the meetings scheduled during the calendar year.
- f. Members will be required to file a State of Florida, Financial Disclosure Form 1 upon being appointment, and Form 1-Final upon resignation, or sunset of term.
- g. As an advisory board, the FPDRAC is subject to the sunshine/open meetings public records and ethics laws of the State of Florida.
- h. To the extent not inconsistent with this Resolution, Section 70-121, et seq., Code of Ordinances, shall apply.
- **SECTION 5:** Qualifications of Members. No FPDRAC member or alternate member shall be an employee of, or hold any elective position or office in, the government of the city. The City Council may appoint any or all of the members to serve jointly on the FPDRAC.
- SECTION 6: FPDRAC Meetings, Officers, and Conduct.
 - a. FPDRAC shall meets on a regular basis. Quorum shall be present for the conduct of regular meetings. A majority of the members appointed shall constitute a quorum. The Chair may call a FPDRAC meeting.
 - b. Meetings will be advertised by the Office of the City Clerk, as required by Florida Statute, so the public may attend and contribute. Reasonable public notice of all meetings shall be provided.
 - c. All meetings shall be governed by Roberts Rules of Order. All meetings shall be open to the public at all times and minutes shall be taken at each and every meeting.
 - d. Upon the initial meeting of the Committee, a Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson will be elected among the members for a one-year term. The responsibilities of the Chair shall be to conduct the meetings in an efficient manner, regulate and facilitate discussions, present recommendations and/or reports to the City Council on behalf of the FPDRAC.
 - e. FPDRAC Chair Duties. The duties of the Chair shall be to:
 - (i) Call meetings to order;
 - (ii) Establish and schedule meetings as necessary;
 - (iii) Develop and provide an Agenda for each meeting;
 - (iv) Preside at the meeting(s);
 - (v) Service as the primary liaison to staff and City Attorney; and
 - (vi) Perform such other functions as may be necessary or directed by City Council.
 - f. Meetings shall be held on a regular schedule, to be determined by the Chair. Meetings that are not regularly scheduled shall not be held without at least three business days prior notice to each member.
 - g. Vice-Chair Duties. The Vice-Chair shall perform the duties of the Chair in the Chair's absence and such other duties as the chair may assign.
 - h. Vacancy. If a vacancy occurs in the office of the Chair, then the position shall be assumed by the Vice-Chair for the remainder of the term. Any FPDRAC vacancy shall be filled through appointment by City Council.
- SECTION 7: Ex-Officio Member and Support Staff. The City Administrator, or designee, shall serve as non-voting ex-officio member of the FPDRAC. Administration and Support Staff for the FPDRAC shall be provided by the City Administrator's office.

SECTION 8: Sunset. The FPDRAC shall sunset and shall not carry out any further duties or responsibilities upon the expiration of one year from the date of the first FPDRAC meeting, or as may otherwise be determined by City Council.

SECTION 9: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR'S AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into this day of $\underline{/5\mu_{1}}$ day of <u>January</u>, <u>2019</u>, by and between CITY OF OKEECHOBEE, FLORIDA, a municipal corporation ("CITY") and ROGER AZCONA of LAW OFFICE OF ROGER AZCONA, ESQUIRE ("SPECIAL MAGISTRATE").

WITNESSETH:

- WHEREAS, the CITY is a municipal corporation in the State of Florida, having a responsibility to provide certain services to benefit the citizens of the CITY and to promote, protect, and improve the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the CITY; and
- WHEREAS, the CITY is desirous of utilizing an attorney to serve as a SPECIAL MAGISTRATE to conduct code enforcement hearings; and
- WHEREAS, the powers and duties of the Code Enforcement SPECIAL MAGISTRATE are set forth in Chapter 18, Articles II and III of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Okeechobee; code enforcement procedures are set forth in Chapter 70, Article II, Division 8 of the City of Okeechobee Land Development Regulations; and
- WHEREAS, the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE is an attorney licensed to practice in the State of Florida, is currently a member in good standing of The Florida Bar, and is currently selfemployed as the Law Office of Roger Azcona, Esquire.
- **NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:
- 1. **Recitals**. THAT the foregoing recitals are true and correct and constitute a material inducement to the parties to enter into this Agreement.
- 2. **Specific Provisions.** THAT the parties hereby agree to the following specific provisions:
 - A. General Scope of Services: The SPECIAL MAGISTRATE shall conduct scheduled code enforcement hearings in accordance with the above-referenced provisions of the City of Okeechobee Code of Ordinances, as may, from time to time, be amended. At the conclusion of the hearings, the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE shall immediately issue an order for each matter heard, containing findings of fact, based on the evidence of record, and conclusions of law, and shall order proper relief consistent with the powers granted to the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE. Additionally, the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE shall have the power to hear requests for reduction of accrued code enforcement fines, following which, the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE shall issue to the City Council, a report and recommendation as to a reduction request. The SPECIAL MAGISTRATE shall invite public comment at every hearing from the offender or any other interested person(s).
 - B. Powers of SPECIAL MAGISTRATE: The SPECIAL MAGISTRATE shall have those powers set forth in the City of Okeechobee Code of Ordinances, as may, from time to time, be amended. Currently, those powers are enumerated as follows: (1) adopt rules for the conduct of hearings; (2) subpoena alleged violators and witnesses to its hearings; (2) subpoena evidence to hearings; (4) take testimony under oath; (5) issue orders having the force of law commanding whatever steps are necessary to bring a violation into compliance; and (6) hear requests for reduction of accrued code enforcement fines.
 - C. **Compensation**: The SPECIAL MAGISTRATE shall be compensated for work completed at the hourly rate of \$150.00 per hour. The CITY guarantees a minimum payment for the first one hour of the hearing, regardless of the actual time expended for the hearing. Should any session continue in excess of one hour, the compensation thereafter shall be computed at the rate of \$37.50 for each quarter hour of hearing time. Additionally, the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE shall be compensated at the rate of \$150.00 per hour for that time engaged in

legal research, issuance of subpoenas, and administrative meetings with staff called by the CITY. There shall be no compensation for travel or per diem from the office/home of the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE to the site of the code enforcement hearing. It is contemplated, but not guaranteed, that there will be nine (9) code enforcement hearing dates per year. The SPECIAL MAGISTRATE shall maintain а time log indicating time expended for research/preparation/meetings/hearings and provide to the CITY along with the monthly invoices. The rate of compensation is subject to amendment by Resolution adoption of the CITY from time to time, at the discretion of the CITY.

- D. **Education**: The CITY will fund periodic continuing legal education courses which are limited solely to code enforcement issues for the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE. The costs for such courses exclude overnight lodging, but include per diem travel and meals, in addition to registration fees. The amount to be funded shall be annually included in the CITY budget, at the sole discretion of the CITY.
- E. **Reimbursement of Costs**: The SPECIAL MAGISTRATE will be provided funds for issuance of subpoenas, but will not be reimbursed for any costs incurred in connection with the services provided in this Agreement that may occur in his office, such as document reproduction, telephone, staff expenses, or other overhead.
- F. **Billing**: A statement for legal services rendered and costs incurred shall be provided on a monthly basis, not later than the 15th day of each month for services rendered in the previous month. The SPECIAL MAGISTRATE will present an itemized bill, which identifies the hours billed for each task or issue. The CITY shall pay all invoices within thirty (30) days of receipt. Service statements shall be sent to the CITY at the address shown in paragraph 2.1.1) herein below.
- G. **Term**: This Agreement shall be for a term of two (2) years, beginning on the 1st day of December, 2018, and ending on the 30th day of November, 2020. This Agreement may be renewed by both parties for additional terms of two years, upon such terms as agreed upon.
- H. Termination.
 - Termination at Will: This Agreement may be terminated by either party at any time without cause by the giving written notice to the other party not less than ninety (90) days prior to the date of termination; provided, that this provision shall not be construed to relieve either party from its rights or obligations of this Agreement through the date of the actual termination. Said notice shall be delivered by certified mail, return receipt requested, or in person with proof of delivery.
 - 2) Termination for Cause: This Agreement may be terminated by either party for cause by the CITY or SPECIAL MAGISTRATE giving written notice to the other party no less than 15 days prior to the date of termination; provided, that this provision shall not be construed to relieve either party from its rights or obligations of this Agreement through the date of the actual termination. Said notice shall be delivered by certified mail, return receipt requested, or in person with proof of delivery.
- I. **Notices**. All notices to the parties under this Agreement shall be in writing and sent certified mail to, or in person with proof of delivery to:
 - 1) **CITY**: CITY OF OKEECHOBEE; Attention: City Administrator; 55 Southeast 3rd Avenue, Okeechobee, Florida 34974.
 - SPECIAL MAGISTRATE: ROGER AZCONA, Esquire, of LAW OFFICE OF ROGER AZCONA, ESQ.; 313 Northwest 4th Avenue, Okeechobee, Florida 34972.
- 3. General Provisions. THAT the parties hereby agree to the following general provisions:

- A. **Representations of the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE**. The SPECIAL MAGISTRATE represents that he has the technical expertise to perform the services contemplated by this Agreement in a timely and professional manner consistent with the standards of the legal profession. At all times the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE shall maintain his standing with the Florida Bar and immediately report to the City Administrator any disciplinary action or suspensions issued by the Florida Bar.
- B. **Personal nature of Agreement; Assignment.** The SPECIAL MAGISTRATE hereby warrants that he has the necessary technical expertise and training to perform his duties as outlined in this Agreement. The parties acknowledge that the CITY places great reliance and emphasis upon the knowledge, expertise and personal abilities of the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE. Accordingly, this Agreement is personal and the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE shall not assign, delegate, transfer, pledge, hypothecate, surrender, or otherwise encumber or dispose of any of his rights or duties under this Agreement.

C. Indemnification and Hold Harmless Agreement.

- The SPECIAL MAGISTRATE shall indemnify and hold the CITY harmless from any and all claims, liability, losses and causes of action which may arise out of the actions of negligence, in whole or in part of the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE, in the fulfillment of this Agreement, including all costs and judgments which may issue thereon. The SPECIAL MAGISTRATE acknowledges and agrees that the compensation paid pursuant to this Agreement includes consideration for such indemnification.
- 2) The indemnification provisions of this paragraph shall survive the termination of this Agreement.
- D. Sovereign Immunity. Nothing in this Agreement extends, or will be construed to extend, the CITY'S liability beyond that provided in Section 768.28, Florida Statutes. Nothing in this Agreement is a consent, or will be construed as consent, by the CITY to be sued by third parties in any matter arising out of this Agreement.
- E. **Professional Independence of the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE**. It is understood and agreed that the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE is not, and will not be deemed to be, an employee, joint venturer, or partner of the CITY. The SPECIAL MAGISTRATE is, and shall remain, an independent professional with respect to all services performed under this Agreement. No partnership relationship between the CITY and the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE is created or intended by this Agreement. The CITY shall rely on the discretion of the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE in the issuance of code enforcement orders, keeping in mind the intent of the CITY to strictly enforce all CITY codes, with the ability to permit limited exceptions in cases of hardship.

F. Conflicts.

- 1) In the event a conflict arises between clients of the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE and the CITY, the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE shall immediately advise the City Administrator of such conflict and resign from such conflicting representation.
- 2) The SPECIAL MAGISTRATE shall not represent other clients in an adversarial position to the CITY while serving as a SPECIAL MAGISTRATE.

G. Records; Access.

 The legislature has amended Chapter 119 Florida Statutes, Section 119.0701 thereof, to expand the obligation of local government to include into all Agreements certain language that relates to public records, which is made a part of this Agreement. IF THE SPECIAL MAGISTRATE HAS QUESTIONS REGARDING THE APPLICATION OF CHAPTER 119, FLORIDA STATUTES, TO THE SPECIAL MAGISTRATE'S DUTY TO PROVIDE PUBLIC RECORDS RELATING TO THIS AGREEMENT, CONTACT THE CUSTODIAN OF PUBLIC RECORDS FOR THE CITY OF OKEECHOBEE AT:

- 2) The SPECIAL MAGISTRATE shall adhere to Florida public records laws, including the following:
 - a) Keep and maintain public records required by the CITY to perform the services, and upon request of the custodian of records for the CITY, provide the CITY with a copy of the requested records or allow the records to be copied or inspected within a reasonable time at a cost that does not exceed the cost allowed in Chapter 119 or as otherwise provided by law.
 - b) Ensure that public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements are not disclosed except as authorized by law for the duration of this Agreement term and following completion of the Agreement if the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE does not transfer the records to the CITY.
 - c) Upon completion of the Agreement, transfer, at no cost, to the CITY all public records in possession of the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE or thereafter keep and maintain public records required by the CITY to perform the service. If the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE transfers all public records to the CITY upon completion of the Agreement, the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE shall destroy any duplicate public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements. If the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE keeps and maintains public records upon completion of the Agreement, the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE shall meet all applicable requirements for retaining public records. All records stored electronically must be provided to the CITY, upon request of the City Clerk, in a format that is compatible with the information technology systems of the CITY.
- 3) Noncompliance:
 - a) A request to inspect or copy public records relating to the CITY'S Agreement for services must be made directly to the CITY. If the CITY does not possess the requested records, the CITY shall immediately notify the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE of the request, and the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE must provide the records to the CITY or allow the records to be inspected or copied within a reasonable time. A reasonable time is defined as within eight (8) business days.
 - b) If the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE does not comply with the request of the CITY for the records, the CITY shall enforce the Agreement provisions in accordance with the Agreement.
 - c) If the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE fails to provide the public records to the CITY within a reasonable time, the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE may be subject to the penalties under Chapter 119.10.
- 4) Civil Action.
 - a) If a civil action is filed against a SPECIAL MAGISTRATE to compel production of public records relating to the CITY'S Agreement for

professional services, the court shall assess and award against the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE the reasonable costs of enforcement, including reasonable attorney fees, If:

- 1. The court determines that the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE unlawfully refused to comply with the public records request within a reasonable time; and
- 2. At least eight (8) business days before filing the action, the plaintiff provided written notice of the public records request, including a statement that the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE has not complied with the request, to the CITY and to the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE.
- b) A notice complies with the above if it is sent to the custodian of public records for the CITY and to the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE at the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE'S address listed on its Agreement with the CITY, or to the SPECIAL MAGISTRATE'S registered agent. Such notices must be sent by common carrier delivery service or by registered, Global Express Guaranteed, or certified mail, with postage or shipping paid by the sender and with evidence of delivery, which may be in an electronic format.
- c) A SPECIAL MAGISTRATE who complies with a public records request within eight (8) business days after the notice is sent is not liable for the reasonable costs of enforcement.
- H. Non-Discrimination. The SPECIAL MAGISTRATE shall assure that no person shall, on the grounds of race, color, creed, national origin, handicap, or sex, be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or otherwise subjected to discrimination in any activity under this Agreement. The SPECIAL MAGISTRATE shall take all measures necessary to effectuate these assurances.
- I. Severability. That, should any term or provision of this Agreement be held, to any extent, invalid or unenforceable, as against any person, entity or circumstance during the term hereof, by force of any statute, law, or ruling of any forum of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect any other term or provision of this Agreement, to the extent that the Agreement shall remain operable, enforceable and in full force and effect to the extent permitted by law.
- J. **Construction**. Should any provision of this Agreement be subject to judicial interpretation, it is agreed that the court interpreting or considering such provision will not apply the presumption or rule of construction that the terms of this Agreement be more strictly Agreement through review by their respective counsel, if any, and/or the negotiation of specific language, and, therefore, the application of such presumption or rule of construction would be inappropriate and contrary to the intent of the parties.
- K. **Compliance with Laws**. The SPECIAL MAGISTRATE, its employees, subcontractors or assigns, shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations relating to the performance of this Agreement.
- L. **Amendment**. No modification, amendment, or alteration in the terms or conditions of this Agreement will be effective unless contained in a written document executed with the same formality as this Agreement.
- M. Waivers. Failures or waivers to enforce any covenant, condition, or provision of this Agreement by the parties, their successors and assigns shall not operate as a discharge or, invalidate, such covenant, condition, or provision, or impair the enforcement rights of the parties, their successors and assigns.
- N. Attorney's Fees. In the event of any litigation to enforce the terms of this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees and costs which are directly attributed to such litigation both at the trial and appellate level.

- Ο. Complete Agreement. This Agreement states the entire understanding between the parties and supersedes any written or oral representations, statements, negotiations, or agreements to the contrary. The SPECIAL MAGISTRATE recognizes that any representations, statements or negotiations made by the CITY staff do not suffice to legally bind the CITY in a contractual relationship unless they have been reduced to writing, authorized, and signed by an authorized CITY representative. The Agreement shall bind the parties, their assigns, and successors in interest.
- Ρ. Headings. All headings are for clarification only and are not to be used in any judicial construction of this Agreement or any paragraph.
- Q. Law; Venue. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida. In the event it is necessary for either party to initiate legal action regarding this Agreement, venue shall be in Okeechobee CITY, Florida.
- 4. Special Provisions.
 - Α. This Agreement shall be construed to be a non-exclusive requirements Agreement and shall not be deemed to prohibit the CITY from retaining additional SPECIAL MAGISTRATE(S) to render services simultaneously for the CITY.
